Debonné Vineyards has been growing its own grapes for four generations making them a true estate winery with more than 120 cultivated acres in the Grand River Valley. The classic, European, family winery produces nationally-recognized, premium wines with quality control that starts in the vineyard and ends in the bottle. Enjoy year round activities such as hot air balloon races, concerts, car shows, Sunday Jazz Fests, and wine and food events among others. Debonné wines can be found in stores and restaurants statewide.

Dinner and a bottle of wine (\$50 value) from **Ferrante Winery & Ristorante** in Geneva. Enjoy a delicious meal with a vista of vineyards, an outdoor patio, tasting room, and award-winning wine at one of Ohio's largest wineries.

A \$50 certificate to **Grand River Cellars Winery and Restaurant**, the Grand River Valley's newest edition located in Madison. This unique winery has a rich history that dates back to 1976 when Grand River Cellars was known as the Grand River Wine Co. The building itself is located far off the main road, which presents a very exclusive setting. The winery is nestled into the woods allowing for afternoon shade on the hot summer days and a tranquil setting during the winter months. Inside you will be welcomed by a warm and inviting atmosphere that includes a beautiful fireplace, many hand painted murals, and a large bar area for friends to gather. Grand River Cellars offers a large variety of appetizers, grilled sandwiches, and a well-rounded dinner menu.

A two-night stay for two at **Fitzgerald's Irish Bed & Breakfast** in the Mayo or Dublin Room, located in quaint Painesville. Fitzgerald's Irish Bed & Breakfast offers warm Irish hospitality in their B&B voted "most affordable luxury" and one of the top 15 B&Bs in North America. This magnificent and recently restored home is a landmark of craftsmanship, from its ornate staircase, hard-wood floors throughout, unusual turret and slate roof, to its elaborate 11-foot fireplace. ### **Southeastern Ohio Wine Country**

grand park lodges built at the turn of the century. Salt Fork Resort & Conference Center is tucked away in the rolling hills of southeastern Ohio, in Ohio's largest state park. The lush wooded surroundings contain miles of hiking and horseback riding trails, large and healthy populations of deer, turkey, flowers, song and water birds all with a view of Ohio's largest state park lake. A \$50 certificate to **Raven's Glenn Winery & Restaurant** in West Lafayette. Raven's Glenn, known as "Ohio's Crown Jewel Of Wineries" is located on the banks of the beautiful Tuscarawas River in East Central Ohio. By combining a classic "wine country" tasting room, an amazing yet casual, Tuscan-style, Italian restaurant, a gift shop filled with unique wine related items, and a full-service banquet room facility, you have an extraordinary winery experience unique to Raven's Glenn.

### **Northwestern Ohio Wine Country**

This package includes a complimentary two night stay at the **Farrell House Lodge at Sunnybrook Trout Club** in Sandusky. Farrell House Lodge is an 1890's replica of a Southern mansion tempered by a gracious lifestyle. It is an ideal getaway retreat located a few miles southwest of Sandusky on the grounds of Sunnybrook Trout Club. Although private by charter, club members and guests of the lodge can fly-fish for trout year-round. The Lodge and club are tucked away on 130 acres of scenic woodlands that are kept as a nature conservancy. Its pastoral meadows and the surrounding landscape play host to an abundance of wildlife. Winding through the property is a two mile stretch of Ohio's legendary Cold Creek, a crystal clear stream which gives shelter to three species of trout. Farrell House Lodge offers ten comfortable guest rooms, including three fireplace suites, available to non-members and Sunnybrook Trout Club members alike. Dinners at the lodge feature fresh trout caught from Sunnybrook's stream and Lake Erie perch during Fish-Fry Fridays as well as weekly chef specials.

A \$25 certificate to **Mon Ami Historic Winery & Restaurant** located in Port Clinton. Mon Ami Restaurant and Historic Winery is one of the oldest wineries in the Lake Erie Islands region. The winery is of further significance as one of the four large co-operative wineries which played an important role in the development of the region's wine industry. Restaurant facilities were added on the ground floor in 1945 following a disastrous fire which gutted much of the interior. In 1956 the restaurant/winery was sold to Norman Mantey, whose family had been engaged in the wine-making business in the Sandusky area since 1880. Mantey retained the Mon Ami name at the facility. The Mon Ami was purchased in 1980 by Meier's Wine Cellars, Inc., the largest wine-making firm in the state. Over much of this period, Mon Ami ranked among the leading wineries in Ohio, producing from 40,000 to 50,000 gallons of wine a year. The present owners purchased the Mon Ami from Meier's in 2000. They have invested large amounts of time and effort in maintaining and enhancing the magic and charm of this wonderful place. A short list of improvements include renovation of the main dining room, the renovation of the Chalet, fabulous new wines, a complete overhauling of the kitchen, food creations beyond belief, and a brand new gift shop.
